Description: Impromptu selection of mostly in progress cases from myself and colleagues.

Notes: Just a quick reflection on an excellent impromptu black box session yesterday 1230-1330 in multiheader room (MS, TB, JD, JK, RH, AO). AO showed a nice case of medullary thyroid ca with difficult immunohistochemistry. MS showed an epithelioid FH, brachial artery fibromuscular intimal dysplasia and two neurofibromas with interesting features. JD showed a difficult cutaneous SCC in progress with moderate keratinisation but horrible dyscohesive growth (making a mockery of Broder grading), and a basaloid proliferation around nerves (possibly collision tumour or basosquame). I showed an EMR oesophagus emphasising how difficult it can be to confirm submucosal invasion and the huge implications for the patient. Finally RH showed how he can diagnose Type 1 diabetes on foreskin histology!
